Visa fee for all other nationals worldwide US\$50 single entry, US\$100 multiple entry, In Europe £50 single entry £100 multiple entry or EC50 single / EC100 multiple.(please note administrative charges apply). ***Please note that all other nations requiring a visa, must submit an application to the Visa Vetting Committee (VVC), through the Immigration Department, for approval before a visa can be issued. This process takes a minimum of 30 days.***

Note Statutory Instrument No 3 of 2015 allows for any visitor who holds a valid multiple entry United States of America (USA) Visa or Permanent Residence Card to enter Belize without a visa.

Please note that there are no fees or deposits payable by holders of Diplomatic & Official passports in cases where visas are needed, such applications must also be sent for the approval of the VVC.
